



MORNING DROP OFF:

- Families with at least one 5th-12th grade student may drop off all children on the Meadow Creek Church side to enter Door 13.
- Families with students in grades K-8 may enter the East Parking Lot at the Heather Street stoplight to drop off at the Academic Entrance Door 7.
- PreK parents may park on either side of the building based on their students' classroom location and use Door 1 or Door 8.

STUDENT DRIVERS:

 ALL student drivers are only allowed to park in the West Parking Lot and enter Door 13. NO student parking is allowed in the East Parking Lot or small church lots except for the Day 1 Celebration.

AFTERNOON PICK UP:

- Families with last names starting with A-K will pick up and exit from the East Parking Lot.
- Families with last names starting with L-Z will pick up and exit from the West Parking Lot.
- Please have your family pickup sign visible in the front passenger window. (Signs will be available at Open House and in your FACTS Family Portal.)

BUS TRANSPORTATION:

- Provided by Anoka-Hennepin School District #11 free of charge for district residents.
- Begins Tuesday, September 3, 2024.
- Bus route details are sent from the district directly to the families at the end of August.
